FINAL NOTICE OF TRUSTEE NOMINATION

It is time for the selection of a Parish Trustee, one of the positions of the Parish as a legal corporation/entity. There are two parish trustees, Christopher Gauthier and Lenny Schaefer, each serving renewable two-year terms. The term of Lenny Schaefer is ending this year.

According to Archdiocesan policy on Trustee Nomination:

- Nominees must be parish members, practicing Catholics and at least 25 years of age.
- Parish staff and permanent deacons are not eligible to serve as trustees.
- Trustees are ex-officio members of the parish council and participate fully in the work of the council.
- The Pastor/Administrator may nominate one (1) candidate per Trustee position open.
- Additional candidates must be nominated in writing by 10 or more parish members.
- If there is more than one candidate, an election will occur in June.

With his consent, I am nominating Lenny Schaefer to serve as parish trustee for a term of two years. If anyone else is interested, kindly submit a nomination as per the above stated regulations. Nomination forms are available from Lori Gabert at the parish office.



THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Where does the word "Trinity" come from?

It comes from the Latin word *trinitas*, which means "three" or "triad." The Greek equivalent is *triados*.

What is the Trinity?

The Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church explains it this way: The Church expresses her trinitarian faith by professing a belief in the oneness of God in whom there are three Persons: *Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.*The three divine Persons are only one God

because each of them equally possesses the fullness of the one and indivisible divine nature. They are really distinct from each other by reason of the relations which place them in

correspondence to each other.

The Father generates the Son; the Son is generated by the Father; the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son [CCC 48].

How can the Trinity be proved?

The Trinity can only be proved through the divine revelation that Jesus brought us. It cannot be proved by natural reason or from the Old Testament alone. The Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church states:

God has left some traces of his trinitarian being in creation and in the Old Testament but his inmost being as the Holy Trinity is a mystery which is inaccessible to reason alone or even to Israel's faith before the Incarnation of the Son of God and the sending of the Holy Spirit.

This mystery was revealed by Jesus Christ and it is the source of all the other mysteries [CCC 45]. Although the vocabulary used to express the doctrine of the Trinity took time to develop, we can demonstrate the different aspects of the doctrine from Scripture.

How can we show from Scripture that there is only one God?

The fact that there is only one God was already made clear in the Old Testament. For example, the book of Isaiah proclaims:

"You are my witnesses," says the Lord, "and my servant whom I have chosen, that you may know and believe me and understand that I am He. Before me no god was formed, nor shall there be any after me [Isaiah 43:10]. (See more at the National Catholic Register: Holy Trinity)
