

STEWARDSHIP OF TIME GROWING IN GENEROSITY ROOTED IN FAITH



Our minutes, hours, days weeks, months, and years are only part of God's generosity. We pray because our faith in that generosity requires a response of our time in prayer. Our faith says that prayer is talking with God daily. That conversation can be praise, petition (self or others), forgiveness, or thanksgiving. That prayer time could be liturgy, adoration, scripture, reflection, spontaneous, memorized or written prayers.

Our belief in a generous God and our need for prayer can expand with time set aside. So be liberal with the **Stewardship of Time**. 1% daily prayer is only 15 Minutes: before anyone is up, at the end of the day, while walking, before a task, anytime. Be grounded in your relationship with God by being open to your time with the Lord.





Be Part of History!

May marked the start of the **National Eucharistic Pilgrimage**, a first for our country. Four groups of

pilgrims will process with *Jesus in the Eucharist* from the four edges of the United States with stops along the way, covering a total of 6500 miles! On July 17th, the four paths converge in Indianapolis for the 10th National Eucharistic Congress, having formed a cross over the country. The Congress is a call to all to renew the Church and our land.

The Marian Route of the national pilgrimage begins in northern Minnesota. This includes a weeklong stay in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee with numerous local stops and events.

Saint Vincent Pallotti- West has the honor of being designated as a stop on June 21st between 2:30 and 3:30.
