June 23, 2024 Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time JB 38:1, 8-11; PS 107:23-24, 24-26, 28-29, 30-31; 2 COR 5:14-17; MK 4:35-41

Our readings today remind us that God always has our best interests in mind. No matter what is going on in our lives, God is with us.

In our Gospel today, Jesus and His disciples are traveling in a boat when heavy winds and violent waves begin to overwhelm the boat. Jesus was there sleeping in the boat in the midst of this horrific storm.

The disciples woke Jesus and questioned Him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" Jesus calms the wind and the waves, and then asks them in return, "Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?"

Think back to a time that you endured great suffering, a hard trial or felt overwhelmed with life. How did you respond?

In moments of trial, we often live our days in a panic. We see the water coming into our boat and we do all that we can in our power to stay afloat. We are frantic, so we fail to stop and recognize that our Savior is in the same boat with us. Although it might feel like He is sleeping and His presence is lacking, He is right there suffering with us.

God won't allow anything that we cannot handle. In a moment of suffering, we might feel trapped. Yet, He sees the moment of peace and still waters.

During our trials, cling to Jesus. Know that there is an end, and whether we see the end in this life or the next, God allows it all for our salvation.

Today, let us thank God for His presence in our lives, and ask for the eyes of faith to see that He is right here with us always.

STEWARDSHIP OF TIME GROWING IN GENEROSITY ROOTED IN FAITH

Our minutes, hours, days weeks, months, and years are only part of God's generosity. We pray because our faith in that generosity requires a response of our time in prayer. Our faith says that prayer is talking with God daily. That conversation can be praise, petition (self or others), forgiveness, or thanksgiving. That prayer time could be liturgy, adoration, scripture, reflection, spontaneous, memorized or written prayers.

Our belief in a generous God and our need for prayer can expand with time set aside. So be liberal with the **Stewardship of Time**. 1% daily prayer is only 15 minutes: before anyone is up, at the end of the day, while walking, before a task, anytime. Be grounded in your relationship with God by being open to your time with the Lord.






Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus Made to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque

Margaret Mary Alacoque said that in her apparitions Jesus promised these blessings to those who practice devotion to His Sacred Heart. The list was tabulated in 1863. In 1882 an American businessman spread the tabular form of the twelve promises throughout the world, in 238 languages.

- 1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
- **2.** I will give peace in their families.
- **3.** I will console them in all their troubles.
- **4.** I will be their refuge in life and especially in death.
- **5.** I will abundantly bless all their undertakings.
- **6.** Sinners shall find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- 7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
- **8**. Fervent souls shall rise speedily to great perfection.
- **9.** I will bless those places wherein the image of My Sacred Heart shall be exposed and venerated.
- **10.** I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.
- 11. Persons who propagate this devotion shall have their names eternally written in my Heart.
- 12. In the excess of the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all-powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour.
