

Once I asked a fallen-away Catholic friend of mine what he remembered about the parish priest from his youth. He said, "He was a gentle, nice guy. Kind of vanilla. Kept to himself." It struck me that he, perhaps like many, perceive Catholic priests as the following: lonely, harmless, and self-sufficient. As a challenge both to this perception (accurate or not) and to us priests who perhaps feel a pull in that uninspiring direction, stands the mighty image of what we see in the Gospel this Sunday.

Jesus sent out his apostles, "two-by-two, with power over demons, and without money belts." Two-by-two: they enjoyed deep fellowship and brotherhood. Power over demons: they were anything but harmless. These men wielded enormous power against evil. Without money belts: they were not self-sufficient. They needed others to help them. Not lonely, but in community. Not harmless but armed with massive spiritual energy. Not self-sufficient, but poor and in need of help.

This is a challenge to me, and perhaps to all of us, living in a rich, secularized, and individualized culture. Do I embrace my priestly ministry in deep fellowship with other priests? Do I speak and act boldly to drive out evil where it is found? Do I live poorly and simply, trusting in the help of those around me even for basic needs? The fruitfulness of priestly ministry largely depends on these three traits. Let's pray for all priests — and, by extension, all of us Christians — to live more like Jesus' communal, poor, and powerful apostles. — Jather John Muir ©LPi

Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Usambara Tanga - Tanzania

The Sisters of Our Lady of Usambara is a growing congregation of over 600 African nuns, whose work is caring for the poor and most deprived people in the

northeastern region of Tanzania. Rt. Rev. Bishop Eugen Arthurs, I. C. founded the congregation in collaboration with Precious Blood Sisters, CPS to address the needs of the local church within the diocese. To date, the Sisters have expanded services outside of the diocese. The area of ministries include teaching religious education to young people, providing services to the poor and the sick, and providing education in schools and colleges. The Sisters provide food and shelter to the poor and needy people and run orphanages for helpless children who have lost their parent to malaria endemic, HIV/AIDs and other killer diseases. They also provide care to malnourished children and medical services to people. There is also a great demand for food, clothing and shelter. Your generous support will be appreciated. 




From the Earth Ministry: Retzer Nature Center

Besides the Catholic Ecology Center in Neosho (promoted in several previous bulletin articles), the Retzer Nature Center just west of Waukesha, is another outstanding place to spend a day this summer, especially if you take your children or grandchildren. This year the Retzer Center is celebrating 50 years of existence. The Center offers many well-maintained and marked hiking

trails, along with a variety of environmental programs delivered through the Environment Learning Center. The Horwitz DeRemer Planetarium is also part of the Nature Center, providing educational programs of astronomical interest.

Friendly Phone Callers

We are looking for volunteers for the Friendly Phone Call Program. The Friendly Phone Call Program is a minimum 12 week commitment that involves making calls to our seniors with the purpose of decreasing isolation.

- Volunteers call clients once per week and fill out an online survey for each call or attempted call. The surveys help assess client needs and keep this program funded.
- Most calls last around 20 minutes but whatever you and the client are comfortable with is fine.
- Calls can be made any time it is convenient for both you and the client, usually between the hours of 10:00AM and 7:00PM.

Reading Tutor Volunteer Opportunity:

If you enjoy working with children and are looking for a way to make a lasting difference in a child's life, this could be the perfect volunteer opportunity. No experience necessary. Volunteers share approximately two hours, one day per week, to help students enhance their reading skills starting in September. Each tutor works one-on-one with the same three students throughout the school year, so meaningful relationships can develop. It is a rewarding experience and a beautiful way to live our faith.

Volunteer tutors are needed at the following Seton Schools: St. Catherine (51st and Center St.), St. Rafael (S. 32nd St. and Lincoln), St. Margaret Mary (92 nd and Capitol Drive), Catholic East (N.
