From the Earth Ministry:

Halloween can produce a lot of waste: used jack-o-lanterns, candy wrappers, cheap costumes, and shoddy decorations.



While it's hard to achieve a completely zero-waste Halloween, it's amazing how close you can get. When carving pumpkins, put on the brakes before throwing out the insides. The EPA says we generate 41 million tons of food waste a year, and it is consistently the largest component found by the DNR in sampling Wisconsin landfills. Track down some recipes for the pumpkin flesh, or try roasting the seeds for a tasty snack. After Halloween, composting jack-o-lanterns is the most eco-friendly disposal method.

For costumes, "shop" in your home's closets or go to St. Vincent DePaul or Goodwill and put together something creative from what you find. A unique outerwear item like a trench coat can transform you into a spy, a leather jacket can add to a 50's rock and roll look, or a fishing vest can make you a safari guide or zookeeper. Keep your costume creations for future years or return them to their places of origin for re-use by others.

For treats as an alternative to candy in throw-away wrappers, you could give out fresh fruit like oranges decorated as jack-o-lanterns, or apples. Some folks make and add caramel apples to their array of treat offerings, wrapping them in biodegradable paper. Also, you can hand out small gifts (e.g., Halloween-themed pencils, erasers, mini coloring books, etc.) or give out quarters or other coins in place of wrapped candy.

Catechesis Corner



- All Saints Day is Friday, November 1. Remember the Saints...your patron Saint and all the many holy men and women that have been role models for us in life. Each of us is called to be a saint...to live the Gospel and bring Jesus, our Savior into this world through our example.
- Did you know...that Halloween and All Saints' Day are closely connected? In the 800s, the Catholic Church began celebrating All Saints' Day. It was originally called All Hallow's Day or Hallowmas. The celebration began early on All Hallows' Eve. But if Halloween is really about the saints in all their victorious glory, where do we get haunted houses, costumes, and tricks?

All Saints' Day became associated with the other deceased rather quickly. November 2 is All Souls Day, where we pray for the souls in purgatory. Throughout the European world, especially with the Celtic and Germanic peoples, the dead were honored in the autumn months. The Celtic pagan celebration of Samhain had its own folk rituals and occurred around the same time as these Catholic feast days.

Within the last few hundred years, this included dressing in disguise and going door to door, asking for food in exchange for a rhyme or poem. Some people masqueraded as "dark" spirits and pulled pranks on others. Today's celebration of Halloween tends to take on these later practices, rather than the original meaning of celebrating the saints. ©LPi

From Communion to Community to Commission: Year 3 of the Eucharistic Revival

Just before ascending into heaven, Jesus commissioned the disciples to be missionaries and bring the gospel message to others. By virtue of our baptism, that commission is handed down to us as well. Let's look once again at the words Jesus used to commission us:

All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age. (Matthew 29: 18-20)

The word "observe" is an interesting word here. How can we teach others to observe what Jesus commanded of his disciples. One of the ways we observe something or someone is to pay attention not only to what is said, but to what is done ... to what is observable. That is at the heart of our mission. Watch carefully, and learn from observing. What am I doing that others "observe" what Jesus commanded? Do my actions reflect Jesus in observable ways? That is faith in action. This week, let's make a deliberate effort to show Jesus to others in our actions. Let's ask ourselves, at least once, WWJD (What Would Jesus Do?).
