

From the Earth Ministry:

Our Environmentally Conscious Neighbors

Milwaukee Montessori School has a

commitment to environment-friendly education and actions. In the last year MMS completed a re-work of their parking lot incorporating porous pavers and a drainage system to minimize harmful run off. But you probably haven't **herd** the latest: In October, MMS delivered another "hands on" eco-object lesson for students, staff, parents and other onlookers, when for one week, a herd of 70 goats was let loose to eradicate invasive plants on the property. A picture is included of the goats happily doing their work.



A couple of years ago, our Earth Ministry members worked aggressively to hand pull/ cut and treat invasives in the common area separating our properties

between the West side of the church and the freeway. Dramatic "before" and "after" pictures appeared in the St. Therese Bulletin. Maybe goats will get the job next time!

- You are explaining your religious beliefs to others, or explaining why we, as Catholics, have Adoration services I have done all these things, and more! Am I successful at these things? Sometimes YES and sometimes NO. Point is, we are Missionaries when we are trying to help others, whether they are asking for help or not! —Art, St. Therese Parish

Let Mary's openness to your wondrous ways be an inspiration to place all trust in you.


