

# Lenten Observances for Fast and Abstinence

The Catholic Church asks each member to preserve the penitential character and purpose of Lent. For this reason:



- Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from meat each Friday of Lent.
- Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, in addition to abstaining from meat, should fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The obligation of fasting ceases with the celebration of one's 59th birthday.

Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

# Safe Environment Week March 30 – April 6

The Archdiocese of Milwaukee recognizes March 30-April 6 as Safe Environment Awareness Week. Each year in the month of April, which is recognized around the country as child abuse prevention month, we dedicate a week to elevating the general awareness of the Church's efforts to keep our children safe. We want people to know that we are committed to maintaining safe environments in our parishes and schools through adult child abuse prevention training; criminal background checks for all clergy, volunteers working with minors, and employees; safety training for children in each grade level; and adhering to all mandatory reporting requirement laws.

WHEREAS, Safe Environment Week is for every parish and school, as well as the entire faith community to focus, at the same time, on the importance of keeping our children and youth safe:

WHEREAS, child abuse and neglect are societal problems whose prevention depend on involvement among people throughout the faith community;

WHEREAS, our children are our most valuable resources and will shape the future of not only the Archdiocese of Milwaukee but also the entire Church;

# From the Earth Ministry: Earth Day 2025



It has been 55 years since the first Earth Day, and with that the birth of the modern environmental movement. Earth Day is celebrated

every year on April 22. The theme this year is "Our Power, Our Planet." Across many traditions, faith teaches care and stewardship of the Earth. The Catholic Church is led by Pope Francis who repeatedly calls on us to be aware of the devastation we are wreaking on the earth and to take responsibility for reparation. Here are some way to be active in earth stewardship:

Milwaukee County Parks welcomes volunteers. Search https://county.milwaukee.gov/EN/Parks/Make-a-Difference/ Volunteer. This can include monitoring wetlands, checking on bees or on birds, or weeding out invasive species so native plants can grow. In addition, you are always welcome to bring your garbage bag along wherever you go and pick up trash.

#### Friends of Honey Creek Parkway

(friendsofhoneycreekmke@gmail.com) will begin meeting weekly on Tuesdays from 4:00–6:00PM in the near future. They will concentrate on pulling invasive plants, especially buckthorn, honeysuckle, garlic mustard and Celandine. Contact their email address to be notified of their start date and other plans.
