

What is Palm Sunday?

Palm Sunday commemorates the entrance of Christ into Jerusalem, during which palm branches were placed in his path, before his arrest on Holy Thursday and his crucifixion on Good Friday. It thus marks the beginning of Holy Week, the final week of Lent.

Is there a donkey in this story?

Yes.

The procession of Jesus into Jerusalem is described by the four Gospel writers in the Bible.

The Gospels differ, but based on one expert they agree on this: Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey.

Joanne M. Pierce, professor emerita of religious studies at the College of the Holy Cross writes that this brings to mind a reference from the Book of Zechariah in Jewish scriptures, where the prophet describes a victorious king who enters Jerusalem riding on a donkey.

In Judaism, she says, the passage from Zechariah refers to the Messiah, a spiritual king who would peacefully redeem Israel, and the donkey is interpreted as a sign of humility.

"In Christianity, this animal becomes almost a symbol of Christ himself, given how it patiently suffers and bears others' burdens," Pierce writes in a piece published by The Conversation. "Horses, on the other hand, tend to be associated with royalty, power and war."

All bishops, priests, deacons, lay parish/school staff, and volunteers are required to follow the mandatory reporting laws of the State of Wisconsin. In Wisconsin, all clergy and all school employees are considered mandatory reporters and can face legal penalties for failing to report suspected or known child abuse or neglect.


