



FINAL NOTICE OF TRUSTEE NOMINATION

It is time for the selection of a Parish Trustee, one of the positions of the Parish as a legal corporation/entity. There are two parish trustees, Christopher Gauthier and Lenny Schaefer, each serving renewable two-year terms. The term of Christopher Gauthier is ending this year. According to Archdiocesan policy on Trustee Nomination:

- Trustees must be parish members, practicing Catholics and at least 25 years of age.
- Bylaws require that trustees be elected every two years, by the parishioners, to serve a two-year term. Trustees serve until their successors are elected.
- Parish staff and permanent deacons are not eligible to serve as trustees.
- The archbishop, as president of the corporation, has the right to approve or disapprove any lay trustee elected by the parish or appointed by the pastor to succeed or to fill temporary vacancies or unexpired terms.
- One trustee is designated as the trustee-treasurer and the other as the trustee-secretary.
- Trustees are ex-officio members of the parish council and participate fully in the work of the council.
- Trustees may not hold office on the parish council nor should they serve as chairpersons of parish committees or liaisons to committees.
- At least one trustee (usually the treasurer) along with the pastor must sign each check issued by the parish.
- Parish trustees are not to initiate or respond to any lawsuit in the name of the parish without the written permission of the archbishop.
- The trustee-treasurer is an ex-officio member of the Finance/Administrative Services Finance or Committee.
- Additional candidates must be nominated in writing by 10 or more parish members.
- If there is more than one candidate, an election will occur in June.

With his consent, I am nominating Christopher Gauthier to serve as parish trustee for a term of two years. If anyone else is interested, kindly nomination as per the above stated submit a regulations. Nomination forms are available from Lori Gabert at the parish office.

From the Earth Ministry: Exposure to harmful chemicals has been



identified at the leading cause of the Parkinson's "Pandemic" we are experiencing. Parkinson's is now the fastest growing neurological disorder with nearly 1.3 million cases in the USA and 10 million worldwide. Between 1990 and 2015 the number of people with Parkinson's doubled. Roughly 200 Americans are diagnosed with the disease every day accompanied by 100 daily deaths.

Although genetics and head trauma may also cause the disease, recent overwhelming evidence has led researchers to conclude that exposure to industrial chemicals, herbicides and pesticides, and solvents can cause Parkinson's. Especially harmful household solvents include nail polish remover, paint thinner and paint stripper. Scientists have concluded that these harmful chemicals are the primary factor causing the dramatic increase in the disease.

The obvious implication is that this is just another reason to avoid exposure to these harmful chemicals and to purchase organic, locally raised and chemical-free fruits, vegetables and other produce. We have in previous articles identified the "dirty dozen" fruits and vegetables to avoid and the "clean fifteen" to embrace. We will reiterate in future articles the healthy choices you can make among these fruits and vegetables.

For anyone who has lived with anxiety, depression, anger, addiction, illness, or a pattern of sin they can't seem to break, it can be difficult to imagine a life of freedom and peace. Participants in the John Paul II Healing Center's Healing the Whole Person will come to understand the wounds at the root of their struggles and how to bring those wounds to the Lord to receive the insight, freedom, and strength He wishes to give, especially through the sacraments and prayer.

Wherever you find yourself now is not the end of your story. God is here. God has more for you. Into the Deep is a time of retreat and inviting God to lead you through.
