





FIRST NOTICE OF TRUSTEE NOMINATION

It is time for the selection of a Parish Trustee, one of the positions of the Parish as a legal corporation/entity. There are two parish trustees, Christopher Gauthier and Lenny Schaefer, each serving renewable two-year terms. The term of **Christopher Gauthier** is ending this year.

According to Archdiocesan policy on Trustee Nomination:

- Trustees must be parish members, practicing Catholics and at least 25 years of age.
- Bylaws require that trustees be **elected** every two years, by the parishioners, to serve a two-year term. Trustees serve until their successors are elected.
- Parish staff and permanent deacons are not eligible to serve as trustees.
- The archbishop, as president of the corporation, has the right to approve or disapprove any lay trustee elected by the parish or appointed by the pastor to succeed or to fill temporary vacancies or unexpired terms.
- One trustee is designated as the trustee-treasurer and the other as the trustee-secretary.
- Trustees are ex-officio members of the parish council and participate fully in the work of the council.
- Trustees may not hold office on the parish council nor should they serve as chairpersons of parish committees or liaisons to committees.
- At least one trustee (usually the treasurer) along with the pastor must sign each check issued by the parish.
- Parish trustees are not to initiate or respond to any lawsuit in the name of the parish without the written permission of the archbishop.
- The trustee-treasurer is an ex-officio member of the Finance/Administrative Services or Finance Committee.
- Additional candidates must be nominated in writing by 10 or more parish members.
- If there is more than one candidate, an election will occur in June.

With his consent, I am nominating **Christopher Gauthier** to serve as parish trustee for a term of two years. If anyone else is interested, kindly submit a nomination as per the above stated regulations. Nomination forms are available from Lori Gabert at the Parish Office.

From the Earth Ministry:

A major cause of the **massive decline in butterfly populations**,




and other pollinators as well, is **neonicotinoid insecticides**. They evade regulation by being applied to the soil or to the seeds, rather than sprayed on plants. They are used on almost all corn seeds and more than half of all soybeans. The plants soak it up as they grow, so the insecticide is incorporated into the leaves, stems, nectar, pollen and fruit. The insecticide damages the insects' central nervous systems, killing outright or weakening them.

The insecticides also regularly **pollute water** sources and **contaminate food**, such as honey, apples, cherries and strawberries. Because they are actually in the fruit and vegetables, they can't be rinsed or peeled off.

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (the CDC) about half of the **US population is exposed** to at least one type of neonicotinoid on a regular basis. They are linked to **muscle tremors, altered insulin regulation, and changes to fat metabolism**.

Though they are not regulated, neonicotinoids must be listed as active ingredients, where you can find them in lawn products, and flea treatments for pets. Names to avoid are *acetamiprid, clothianidin, dinotefuran, imidacloprid* and *thiamethoxam*.

The Archdiocese of Milwaukee also has a third-party reporting mechanism for misconduct through Convercent. All mandatory reporting laws in the State of Wisconsin are required to be followed with all reports to the Archdiocese of Milwaukee or Convercent. A report of abuse can also be made through the Advocate Aurora Healing Center or directly reported to the appropriate civil authorities.




