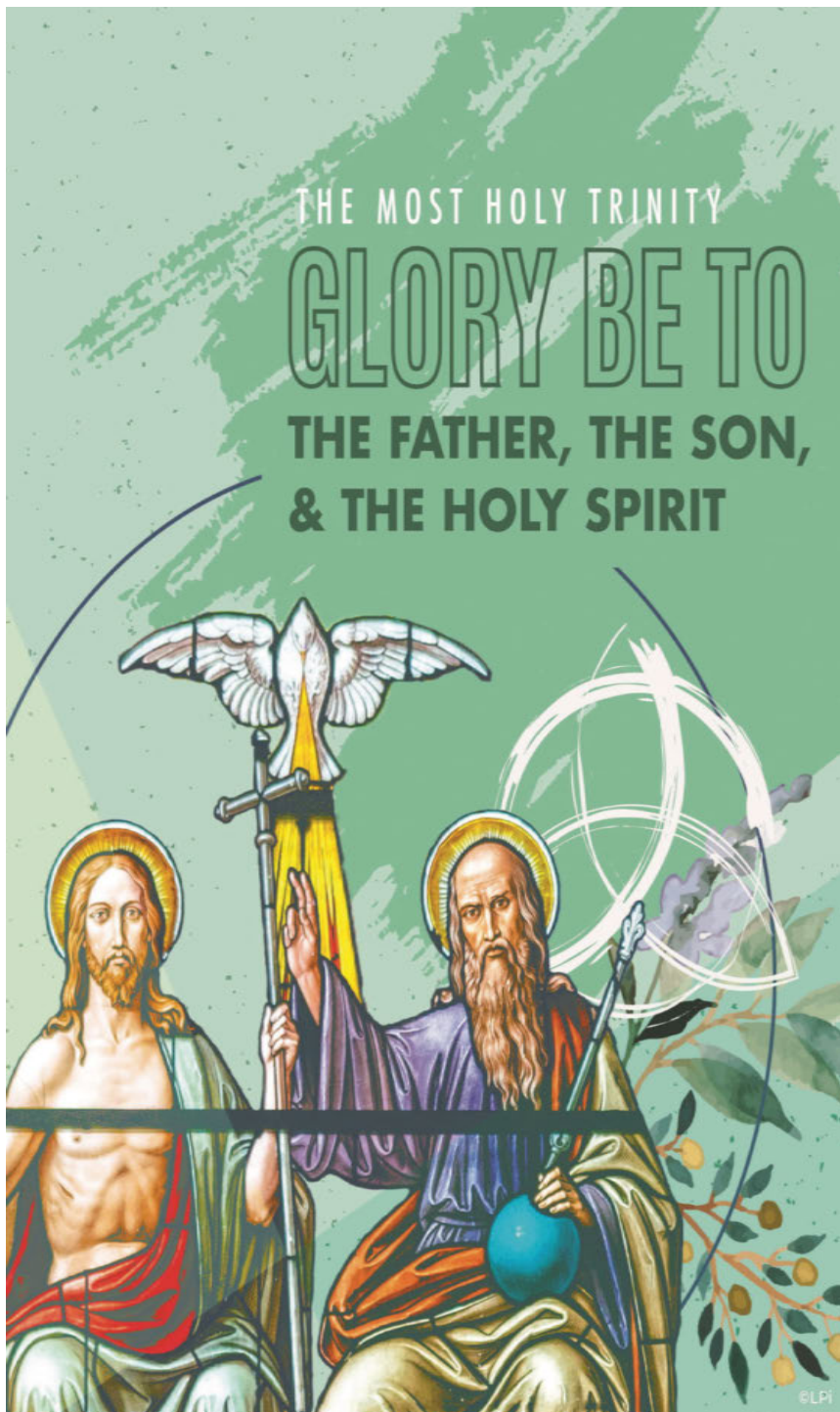

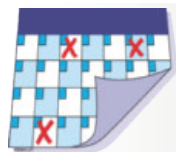

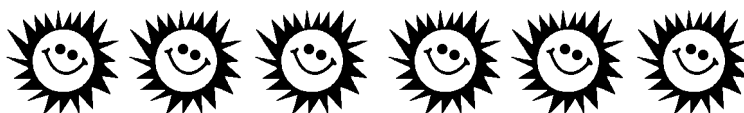

St. Therese Needs Your Help!

Our landscaping has been neglected and shows it. Would you be willing to exhibit “the little way of St. Therese” with our landscaping, restoring it to its welcoming beauty? After all, in St. Therese's writings, flowers are often seen as symbols for acts of love. There are several areas that need immediate attention! You can work in a group or by yourself. Immediate needs include:



- Trimming the bushes and removing dead branches on the shrubs on the 95th St. side of the building
- Three sides of the St. Therese electronic sign are filled with thistles and other weeds; these need to be weeded and planted (one side has been restored)
- Apply mulch to the planted areas (keep weeds down and moisture in, besides looking lovely)
- New plantings need watering. Can you sign up for a week?
- Several areas still need to be weeded; can you sign up for one or more areas? Are you able to weed periodically (darn, those weeds like to come back!)
- More plants are needed south of the Chapel door where the dead bush was removed last year
- Do you have any slow growing perennials? Extra annuals? We have been gradually adding plants, but more are needed. Plants and mulch help keep weeds away.
- The Monarch Trail is close by. Perhaps you have (or would like to purchase and donate) butterfly friendly plantings?

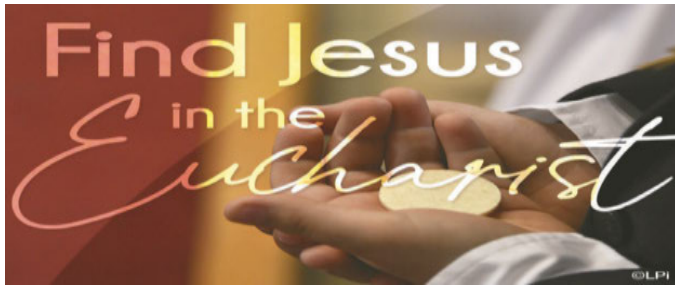

Did You Know???

What is a Eucharistic Procession?

A Eucharistic Procession, just like Eucharistic Adoration, is an extension of the worship of Jesus Christ, truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. The supreme act of adoration and the source and summit of the Christian life is the celebration of the Mass, and that celebration is prolonged and intensified through Eucharistic worship outside of the Mass. In Eucharistic Processions, the missionary aspect of the Eucharist is emphasized as we go forth into the world. Not only gazing upon our Eucharistic Lord, but walking with him, we experience what the disciples did 2000 years ago as they walked with Jesus, proclaiming the Good News to the world. A parish community that undertakes a Eucharistic Procession has made the decision to publicly proclaim its belief in Jesus' True Presence in the Eucharist. By this public witness of faith, the parish invites people in the community to encounter the Risen Lord present in the Eucharistic Host. For those who participate in the procession, it is an opportunity not only to proclaim their faith but also to grow in their faith. The procession is, finally, an invitation to Jesus himself to be a part of our daily lives, to be immersed in the world in which we live.

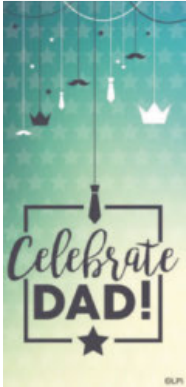

Standing Committee Monthly Reports:

Stewardship Committee

At our last meeting, the stewardship committee finalized two initiatives for the SVP parish picnic. These included encouraging everyone at the picnic to wear name tags and setting up a parish welcome table. Both initiatives proved to be successful. The name tags were well received by people and we had a good turnout at the welcome table. We gave away a total of 52 books to guests who wanted to learn more about the church and their faith, along with numerous pocket prayers. The children who stopped by also loved the bookmarks and the candy. Father PC brought a young couple over and encouraged them to fill out a parish registration form. The committee will be recommending the use of a welcome table at future parish events.

Planning also continued for two future events to be held in both parishes. A new parishioner registration drive in August and the annual stewardship campaign in October.

Prayer and Worship Committee

Specific details need to be sent to the Archdiocese in advance when a bishop or archbishop is presiding at an event. In addition to involving St. Therese and St. Vincent Pallotti, the Syro Malabar community (who normally worship at the St. Therese site) along with its choir will also participate. There are many moving pieces to this unique celebration, and time and care is being taken to make this a most prayerful and profound experience for all who attend.

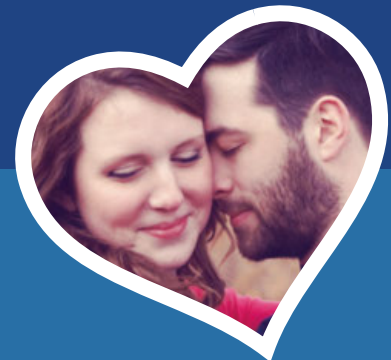
