

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 10:25-37

I used to be a bad neighbor. I'd get wrapped up in my life and ignore those around me. Then I found sage advice from Benjamin Franklin to this effect: to be a better neighbor, ask someone to do a favor for you. It's counterintuitive, isn't it? Tell strangers that I need their help? Yuck. I'll risk looking needy. Worse, I'll be indebted to them. But I tried it, and it works like a charm. Recently I asked my neighbor Alan for a hacksaw, and Inga for an egg. They kindly obliged, and our friendship is growing.

This week we hear a scribe of the law cynically ask Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" (Luke 10:29). Like him, we prefer to keep the list of our "neighbors" as short as possible. It requires less interruption and inconvenience. But when Jesus tells the parable of the Good Samaritan, he exposes the lonely, cold-heartedness tendency of the scribe's (and our) heart. My "neighbor" is anyone I encounter who manifests a concrete need. There isn't time to require any other credential because human need opens us to the happy reciprocity which is love.

Jesus' words challenge us this week to ask a neighbor for help in some small way. How marvelous that God himself shows us how. He moves into our world and asks us to love Him with small deeds of love. Maybe that's where Ben Franklin got the idea.



Standing Committee Monthly Reports Stewardship Committee

The stewardship committee completed work on the combined St. Therese and St. Vincent Pallotti Ministry Opportunity booklet. This booklet summarizes the liturgical ministries, the standing committees and all other volunteer opportunities in the two parishes. It will be sent to parishioners from both parishes as part of our fall stewardship campaign.



From The Earth Ministry:

In 2022, Milwaukee became the home of the world's tallest (at 25 stories) timber / timber-concrete hybrid office and residential high-rise. Ascent Tower,



which has retail space on the lower levels and 259 luxury apartments on the upper floors, is located at 200 E Kilbourn Ave. Ascent's claim-to-fame will likely be short lived because a new kind of "Superwood" will certainly spur more timber-based urban buildings.

"SuperWood", which is up to 50% stronger than steel and with a strength-to-weight ratio 10 times greater, is approaching full-scale production by the Maryland-based InventWood company. "Superwood" is transformed from ordinary timber to create a significantly less carbon-intensive, sustainable and cost-effective alternative to steel and concrete in construction projects.

Regular timber is composed mostly of cellulose and lignin. The timber is transformed into SuperWood via a proprietary, non-toxic densification process using food-safe chemicals to remove lignin. Then precision-controlled compression is used to create strong hydrogen bonds between cellulose fibers.

SuperWood maintains the aesthetic qualities of premium wood and is suited for diverse applications including structural-grade beams, interior furnishings, and cladding. With a Class A fire rating, it can be used even in fire-prone regions. InventWood also claims it is resistant to rot and pests. The mass availability of SuperWood is clearly a win-win for builders and environmentalists.




